Crime/Traffic report from Captain Dennis Andreas

Capt. Andreas provided an update on crime in the neighborhood. Crime in Del Ray is down and helping to lower the city average. The police department is investigating recent larceny cases and recommended locking up bikes when they are stored outside. DRCA asked for an update on automobile crashes on Mt. Vernon Ave; Capt. Andreas reported four crashes over the course of the year. The threshold for reporting a crash is \$1500 in damage which could lead to to underreporting of accidents.
