- Evan Wilson presented on Blessings in a Backpack; majority of kids at MVCS are Free and Reduced Price lunch, but the school is not a title 1 school, so there is no provision for meals outside of school time.
- The program provides food for 125 students, no need to fill out forms. Takes ~\$20k a year to run the program; about \$150 can provide food for one kid for a year.
