Crime/Traffic report from Captain Dennis Andreas

Citywide YTD looking good, down double digits in all categories including larceny. In Del Ray, all categories are down this YTD

Since last meeting, 8 offenses in Del Ray:

- 6 larcenies (half of what we had this time last year)
 - 5 larcenies were related to shoplifting CVS Mt Vernon, Walgreens, CVS Richmond Hwy
 - 1 larceny was credit card theft USAA caller ID, was not USAA, asked security
 questions and seemed very legit. Tip: hang up, call number on back of your credit
 card to restart conversation with your legitimate financial institution; APD working
 on leads
- 1 Robbery: 711 on 2100 block of Mt Vernon
 - suspect took out hammer and stole cigarettes; it was an armed robbery, APD working on leads
- First stolen vehicle of year
- 10 traffic crashes
 - 4 on MVA corridor all minor, no reports taken
 - 2 were intersections (Braddock & MVA, E Del Ray & MVA)
 - o other 2 were mid-block addresses, speculating parking-related

Q: pedestrian related accident in Arlandria

A: don't have much to share

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Q: TCC working with City on MVA designation, looking at traffic issues - don't want to abuse our requests but can we from time to time request the non-reportable information?

A: Yes, we are happy to share notes from non-reportable calls, but sometimes there isn't much information to share

Q: Accident at Del Ray & MVA - called non-emergency number. Is it good to call even if it looks minor and drivers have exchanged information?

A: Yes, no requirement to do that if folks going to work it out on their own, but yes if you want to call you always can. When in doubt, always give us a call – gives us more data points, facilitate the information exchange, put notes in the record, etc

Process - ACPS redistricted in 2018. Policy to revisit every 5 years, ACPS has been collecting data for last few years

- Equitable utilization
- Prioritize neighborhood schools
- Demographic alignment

Data on where things stand now

- utilization (MVCS at 120%)
- All schools should be between 90-110%
- MVCS over utilization driven by transfers

Q: any plans to address MVCS crowding?

A: will also update policies in addition to updating boundaries, transfer into dual language program is parallel up for discussion

Q: any plans for another dual language program?

A: Jessica will take this feedback back to the group, Ryan offered to speak with anyone who'd like to discuss further

Next school board mtg will discuss, upcoming meetings will prioritize policies

Potential for other dual language programs - we are aware of the interest, doing programmatic reviews and considering opening more slots.

Timing - redistricting this spring, policies on another timeline

Q: mtg today - implied that more maps coming out that will impact MVCS?

A: iterative process, 3 maps are not the only ones. RAC and community all engaging. These maps assume the JH conversion but now that city council likely not including in CIP, we have to rethink use of space and additional maps will be coming out. Maybe one with bigger zone for JH to bring it to full utilization including policies

Maybe one that allows for MVCS programmatic transfers but maybe one that does not

Q: in policy discussions, any consideration of Cora kelly rebuild impacting zoning?

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A: when Cora kelly and George Mason come back online, there will be a mini relook at boundaries based on more space in new buildings

These maps assume current facilities but do factor in timeline of rebuilds Also projecting new housing developments

Q: if kids currently opting into MVCS, can they continue?

A: grandfathering - among policies up for consideration by board in upcoming meetings
