## 7:16pm: Special Guest Jonathan Whiteleather; Commonwealth, Glebe, Ashby Flood Mitigation Project (Presentation Link)

- Project is to improve capacity of flooding caused in Glebe Rd Area
- Will be approximately 3 years of construction beginning in summer 2026
- Culvert system is 2 8 foot by 7 foot culverts, which is what allows this system to improve the flooding situation
- Will maintain access to residences and businesses, may have impact to sidewalks
- There are 2 8'x9' box culverts, they are all underground
- Potential significant traffic impacts between E/W Glebe, to E/W Reed major construction needed in this area
- Completing design this fall, procurement for contract in the spring, construction Summer 2026-2029
